Mural That Once Upset Town Makes History Featured At National Museum

ANSON- In the arid little town of Anson out on the West Texas plains, the only jug of corn whiskey you're likely to find is the one in the picture on the post office wall. And even that one part of a depression-era mural raised a ruckus when it was unveiled 57 years ago.

The mural, the work of Woodstock, N.Y. born artist Jenne Magafan, depicts a raucous cowboy dance. The jug rests at the feet of a banjo player.

Evidently Miss Magafan did not realize that throughout the history of Anson there has never been an open saloon," one local sniped after the mural's unveiling. "Nor did she know that the people of Anson continue to vote against liquor stores."

"It definitely raised eyebrows," Postmaster Von Byrd said as the artist's study for the mural

and a photograph of the artwork went on display at a Washington, D.C., museum. "I'm told in the community that when it came out people were very upset. They just did not have jugs at the dances here."

The mural, one of 61 in Texas commissioned by the Fine Arts Section of the Treasury Department, is among 17 featured in "Our town: Post Office Murals of the New Deal Era" at the National Postal Museum through September 8.

Magafan, born in 1915 or '16 confusion surrounds the date was an established artist when she joined the public works program in the 1930's. Hundreds of artists were employed, generally receiving \$1,536 for each work, out of which they were to buy supplies and cover travel expenses. About 1,000 of the murals survive.

It is uncertain whether Magafan ever visited Anson, population 2,806, about 20 miles northwest of Abilene.

Magafan, who died in 1950, also painted murals in Colorado, Utah, Nebraska, California and at the Social Security building in Washington D.C. During her lifetime, her paintings were displayed at an array of prestigious museums in Denver, San Francisco, New York City and Washington, D.C. Her work also has been exhibited at the White House.

I think people out here who see it on a daily basis recognize it as a treasure" said Byrd, the Anson postmaster. "They may not comment on it. But there aren't that many of these painting left. It's a neat deal. It's our treasure.
